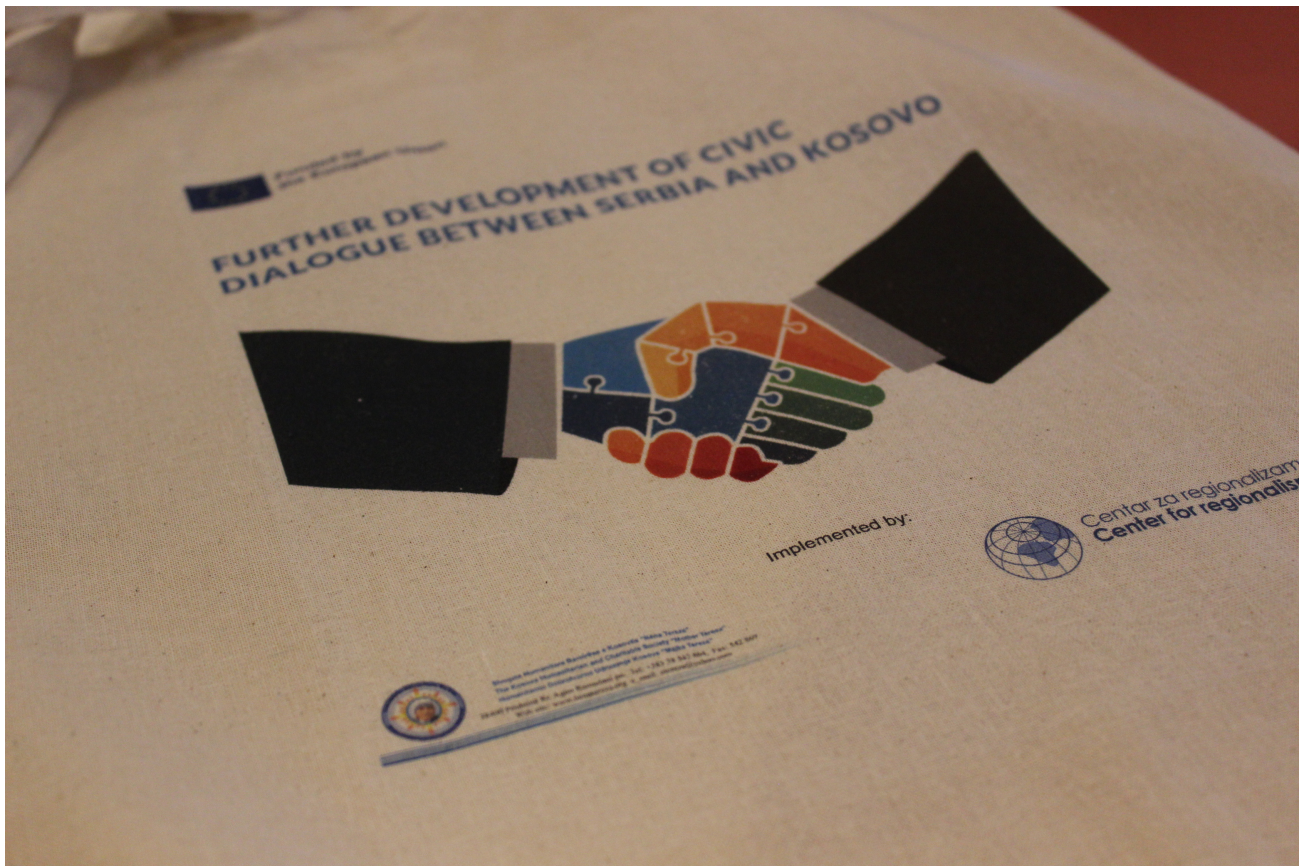

## Project Details

### Background

Kosovo-Serbia dialogue for several years has assumed a central role in politics with an impact across social systems, such as the economy, education, and the everyday life of citizens. As a platform for the normalization of good neighbourly relations, the Kosovo-Serbia dialogue has been a part of the civil society organizations' work who have advocated for a transparent process and inclusion of civil society actors to give voice and offer bottom-up approaches to issues of importance for citizens. Civil society organizations have a crucial role to play in sustaining a culture of dialogue across communities in Kosovo and between Kosovo and Serbia, on dealing with the past and building a shared understanding leading towards rapprochement. However, the Kosovo-Serbia dialogue needs to open-up space for civil society actors and include citizens' voices to ensure full normalization of relations

### Goals

**The overall objective** of this Action is to contribute in building a good neighbourly relation between Serbia and Kosovo through civil dialogue.

### Objective and Scope

- Action will provide support in establishment of cooperation of youth from Kosovo and Serbia in the areas of employment, education, environment and culture (**specific objective 1**) and
- will also provide support for active engagement in civil dialogue of youth, women and national minorities in multi-ethnic communities in Serbia and Kosovo (**specific objective 2**).

### Deliverables

- At least 30 joint proposals** from youth CSOs from Kosovo and Serbia in the areas of employment, education, environment and culture **applied to Call**
- At least 15 proposals** selected from youth CSOs from Kosovo and Serbia
- At least 30 representatives of selected youth CSOs from Kosovo** and Serbia participated in the capacity building in the area of civil dialogue;
- At least **15 joint activities of CSOs** in the areas of employment, education, environment and culture in communities in Serbia and Kosovo implemented successfully;
- At least **15 monitoring visits** and meetings with selected youth CSOs held during implementation;
- At least **1 discussion between young participants from youth CSOs from Kosovo and Serbia** and well-known ethnologists about the elements of the common cultural heritage of Albanians and Serbs and other peoples living in Kosovo and Serbia held;
- 3-day camps in Prizren and Vranje held**; a **1 joint theatre play** and **1 joint exhibition** organized
- At least **50 representatives of youth CSOs** participated in the conference
- 1 joint action Green Agenda** for cleaning of the Ibar river with at least **50 participants organized and held**
- At least 5.000 people/general public** informed through media and marketing campaign on joint activities of youth CSO's in Serbia and Kosovo

- Signed a **Memorandum of understanding** for support in civil dialogue in **20 multi-ethnic communities in Serbia and Kosovo**
- Conduct **research about situation of youth, women and ethnic minorities in selected communities in Serbia and Kosovo**
- At least 20 round tables organized** to present and discuss findings of the research with at least 100 representatives in total
- Organized **2 study visit** to Serbia and Kosovo of at **least 30 local stakeholders**
- Supported 20 joint activities in 20 selected multi-ethnic communities** in Serbia and Kosovo that contribute to active engagement of youth, women and ethnic minorities
- At least **4.000 people/general public in 20 selected communities** informed through media and marketing campaign on joint activities
- Organize **2 final conferences in Belgrade and Prishtina** to present the results of the supporting active engagement for civil dialogue in multi-ethnic communities for at least in total 100 representatives
